Levels of Commitment to God's Kingdom

Six steps of commitment to God and His Church:

Survival

I commit some time, talent and/or money only in order to keep the Church running. My motivation is that at some time in my life the Church might help me survive through a difficult time and I want the Church to be there if and when I need it.

Supermarket

I am happy to commit time, talent and/or money towards those bits of the Church I want and enjoy. My motivation is as a customer wishing to deal with the Church on my terms, safe and unchallenged.

Support

I commit time, talent and/or money to the Church because its work is important. My motivation is to be a member of a supporters club.

Subscription

I commit time, talent and/or money because I wish to contribute my fair share to the running of the Church. My motivation is to be identified as a Church member playing my part.

Submission

I commit time, talent and/or money to the Church because I am a Disciple of Christ, which means putting God first in my life. My motivation is responding to God's love and generosity to me, not just the needs of the Church.

Sacrifice

I commit my whole life to Christ, my time, talent and money. My motivation is to be Christ-like, giving joyfully and sacrificially – following Christ.
