

# Happy Christmas to everyone from Purton Churches What is News?

I meet many people who have stopped watching "the news" because it is too bad to see, others because it does not fit with what they want to hear. There has been some discussion recently about bias. Also many have been shocked to discover that news from certain outlets is filtered by a computer algorithm which only shows news which supports the consumer's existing views.

In the midst of all this uncertainty God breaks in with His news to the shepherds near Bethlehem, His angel said, "I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people. Today in the town of David a Saviour has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord." [Luke chapter 2 verses 10-11 The Bible]. This message would be good news and bring great joy to the ordinary people. But it would be bad news for King Herod and for the religious authorities, it would be bad news for any who did not think they needed a saviour for all the wrong things they had done. Yet it would be good news for those who realise their need and are willing to receive God's solution, God's promised Messiah, God's all powerful Lord.
